Door & Offering

- Please ensure you're at church by **10:15am for the morning service**, and **4:15pm for the evening service** to begin welcoming people.
- As the church begins filling up, one of you should ensure that people squeeze together to keep space free. Keep the aisles free from chairs.
- As part of your duty, could one of you please take up the offering and **help Nic Lotz count the offering** after the service.

Crèche

- Crèche at Archer Street is held in the meeting room on the right as you enter the building. Speak to Rene or Jesse if it's locked.
- Please remember to do a safety check of the room **before church**.
- Children's toys will be available in the storage room, and should be returned to the storage room when crèche is finished. For the remainder of the week, this room is used for meetings.
- On the first Sunday of the month, the fellowship lunch is held in the crèche room, so this needs to be cleared in time for lunch set-up.
- If you are unavailable, please arrange a swap and **let Bronwyn know**. If you have a Child First-Aid Certificate (in bold on the roster), you need to ensure you swap with someone who has a First Aid Certificate.
- In last-minute cases, the backup person for the crèche is **Alicia 022 479 6804**, and please let Bronwyn know.
- FIRST AID - It's necessary that the person with the first aid qualification is **always** in the crèche room, therefore children possibly needing the toilet can be taken by someone else.
- PARENTS - please take your children to the toilet **before church and/or crèche**.

Morning Tea

- Please bring along some **milk** (just in case) and biscuits/cake as a snack. Coffee, tea, sugar etc should be in supply.
- Children should have their parents' **permission** to come and get food or drink.
- On **Fellowship Sundays** (in bold), your role is to **supervise** the young people who will help clean up. If you're short of young people to help, please speak to one of the deacons (Graham, James, Jesse, Tom) who will round up more.
